Department of General Surgery The Surgical Oncology Unit has marked another achievement. Dr. Raed Al Marzoog, General Surgeon, Surgical Oncologist, and Colorectal Surgeon, performed a successful laparoscopic right hemicolectomy a 70-year-old patient with a confirmed cancerous colon tumor. Pre-operative investigations, including CT scan imaging and biopsy, helped stage the tumor and address obstructive symptoms. The right colon containing the tumor was removed, and the intestine was reconnected with the remaining part of colon. The patient recovered well, was discharged within five days, and remains in good health following subsequent follow-up, thanks to God. The cancerous tumor was found to have extended into the surrounding fat, and despite this, we achieved clear margins with 6 out of 25 lymph nodes showing to be affected. The case has been presented to the oncology center for consideration of adjuvant Chemotherapy.

Timely Intervention Saves Patient's Life


During a routine outpatient follow-up for hypothyroidism with Internal Medicine Specialist Dr. Nagesh Babu, a patient presented with very low pallor, dizziness, and inability to stand, despite stable vital signs. The doctor referred the patient to the emergency department where she was found to have a sever low hemoglobin level of 2.7 gm%. Immediate ICU admission and investigations revealed autoimmune hemolytic anemia, with indicators suggesting possible SLE (Systemic Lupus Erythematosus). The patient received urgent care, including three units of washed, packed red blood cells bags and intravenous methylprednisolone 1 gm% I.V for 3 successive days. Her condition improved significantly under the care of Internal Medicine Consultant Dr. Ahmad Elsebaaie, Hematologist Dr. AbdulJalil Alashiri, and the ICU team, with her hemoglobin reaching 8.3 gm%. She has been discharged for ongoing follow-up with Consultant Rheumatologist Dr. Abdulkhalea Aloraibi to further investigate the possibility of SLE.

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Tongue Tie Case for 13 Years **Old Patient**

Tongue tie also known as Ankyloglossia is a condition where there is restricted tongue movement due to a short and thick band of tissue called the lingual frenum that tethers the tongue to the floor of the mouth.

This condition is present from birth and may cause a problem with breastfeeding and later with speech, eating and oral hygiene. It results in a typical notch or heart shaped appearence of the tongue.

While mild cases may require no treatment, moderate to severe cases require a minor surgery called lingual frenectomy which maybe performed with a conventional scalpel or laser.

The advantages of using a laser include little or no bleeding, no sutures and quick healing with minor discomfort all of which lead to greater patient acceptance as well.

The below case is for a 13 year old boy reported to Al Kindi Hospital dental department complaining of tongue tie causing difficulty in eating, speech and oral hygiene.

Laser frenectomy was carried out under local anesthesia to free the tongue from the floor of the mouth. The procedure was completed in under 30 min with minimal to no bleeding, no sutures and immediate results with quick healing and minimal discomfort.


