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



ANNUAL OPERATIONAL PLAN

Having a strategic plan is essential to any company, but it's not enough. To ensure that the broader organizational goals are within reach, we need an operational plan for day-to-day work.

An annual operational plan is the dayto – day actions taken to invest in

- Increasing revenue (new service, marketing, new employment.... etc)
- Time (by having a software, equipment or more staff to accomplish tasks in a shorter and more efficient way) / Buying time.
- Increasing safety (for customers, staff or the facility)
- Increasing security (facility or information)
- Resource management (proper utilization / minimization of resources used)
- Patient feedback, complaint or complements (how did we benefit to improve our service or patient satisfaction)

Benefits Of an Annual Operating Plan

1. Alignment and focus on key business priorities

An annual operating plan provides a clear roadmap toward a shared vision and helps everyone in our team understand their roles in meeting business objectives. It promotes collaboration and communication while eliminating silos, fostering a unified, goal-driven work environment.

2. Enhances productivity

An operational plan enhances productivity by establishing timelines, outlining objectives, and allocating resources. This structure helps team members prioritize their work and manage their time efficiently because they have clear deadlines to guide them.

By defining precise objectives, the plan ensures every team member understands their specific tasks and expected outcomes, preventing unnecessary work and deviations from the plan. And knowing what resources are available helps team members prepare realistically for their taskwork.

3. Controlled strategy execution

By defining specific Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) and milestones in our AOP, we can easily assess whether the company is on track to achieve its goals. These metrics will help us identify areas that require immediate course correction to stay aligned with the overall strategy.

4. Enhances productivity

A well-rounded AOP provides us with data to help us make the right decisions. These insights empower proactive responses to opportunities and challenges, ensuring that all team actions are focused on outcomes.

What can we do before starting our Operational Plan?

1. Assess our current situation

- Look back at our performance over the last year and consider what we achieved in relation to our aims and objectives.
- Review how closely aligned our performance was with company values and our mission. This will help us to reset our planning for the next year.
- Consider actions that did not achieve the necessary results. For example, did a new service launch fail to spark the expected revenue boost?
- Consider what we can learn to refine our processes going forward or whether we should cancel some activities and seek out other opportunities instead.
- Analyze all areas of the business to ascertain where we can make improvements.

2. Analyze the market climate

- The risks in our health sector will have a bearing on our planning for the forthcoming year. There is no point in pursuing a plan that is destined not to work because the market climate is incompatible with its success.
- Keeping a keen eye on the industry press to spot market trends that will help us set KPIs that chime with the business environment in which we will be working.
- Make use of competitive analysis to see what our peers are doing and how they work.
 This will identify opportunities to diversify and gain an advantage over our competitors.
 Use a SWOT analysis to better understand their strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats.

3. Build our business strategy

- Develop a strategy that will allow us to meet our objectives, given the risks and challenges that lie in store.
- Meet with the management and the department heads to discuss what they want to achieve during the year and what they need from us to meet those objectives.
- Use historical data to give us a realistic read and help us move forward.

3. What to include in the annual operational plan?

Using the information we have gathered; we can begin to create a framework for the day-to-day activities that will comprise our operational plan.

- Set KPIs to help us monitor progress during the year
- Allocate the necessary resources
- Assign responsibilities for the selected teams.

Once we have selected the areas on which we want to concentrate for the twelve months ahead

- Set SMART GOALS to achieve the growth that we require. These are goals that are Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant and Time-bound.
- Ensure goals are relevant by aligning them with our company mission and they are time-bound by setting them for the full term of our annual operating plan.
- Include budget and financial planning which allocates how that budget works in a practical manner to achieve the goals and objectives.
- Include sales targets to help us achieve the results we need to carry out our plan.
- Risk mitigation plans

What Is an Operational Plan Template?

- It is a form that captures key details about a work plan. An operational plan includes specific actions and resources needed to reach certain milestones. It is more detailed and specific than a strategic or business plan.
- It helps project managers identify resource needs, maintain accountability, implement a reporting process, and maintain a budget.
- Operational plan templates vary by type but typically include the following:
- **Title:** Enter the plan name or title.
- Goals: Enter specific goals or milestones of your plan (SMART format).
- Executive Summary: Describe the plan in a short paragraph and specifies if it relates to other plans in our organization.
- **Leader:** Name of the leader of the plan.
- Resources Needed: Enter all resources necessary to complete each task, including onhand resources and those you will need to procure.
- Team: Include the names of the team members who are responsible for each task (each member roles & responsibilities).
- **Target:** What you want to achieve.
- **Budget:** Write the cost or needed budget if needed for your goal/project.
- Risks: Note any risks you may encounter.
- Objectives to achieve: Write down the objectives /steps to achieve your goal.
- Evidence of Success: Write a short statement explaining how you will know when the goal has been achieved (from the result of the monitoring tool/s used).
- Start and finished Date: Start & completion dates for each task in the plan.
- Monitoring tool: Mention how you will monitor the success or gaps for improvements in your project/plan?
