




Medical Achievement Rapid Intervention Saves a 70 Year Old Patient's Life Inside The Ambulance

A 70-year-old man arrived at Al Kindi Hospital's emergency department complaining of dizziness, general fatigue, and shortness of breath with usual exertion. He also had heart palpitations for two days. His medical history included high blood pressure, diabetes, and dyslipidemia. He was examined in the cardiology department under the supervision of Dr. Mahmoud Saraya, a cardiology consultant.

An echocardiogram revealed dilated cardiomyopathy, a condition where the heart muscle is weakened and enlarged, with an ejection fraction of 37%. An electrocardiogram (ECG) also showed a second-degree heart block. Due to his condition, Dr. Mahmoud Saraya decided to transfer the patient to a specialized government cardiology center for the urgent implantation of a pacemaker. The patient's condition was stable during the transfer through the ambulance until shortly before arrival, when he experienced a sudden cardiac arrest due to ventricular tachycardia. The medical team, including Dr. Basily Samir, Intensive Care Specialist, immediately performed cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and used an automated external defibrillator (AED) to deliver electric shocks. Within three minutes, the patient regained consciousness, and his vital signs were restored.

The patient was delivered to the specialized center fully conscious and in stable condition, where he was handed over to the medical teamfor continued care. This incident demonstrates the dedication and efficiency of the medical staff and paramedics in their rapid and effective intervention to save a critical patient's life.





Removed a Large Tumor and Saved the Spleen

The General Surgery, Laparoscopic Surgery, & Oncology department is proud to announce another major achievement. Led by Dr. Raed Al Marzooq, General Surgeon, Surgical Oncologist, and Colorectal Surgeon, the surgical team successfully performed a complex laparoscopic procedure to remove a large tumor from the spleen of a 28-year-old patient. Instead of removing the entire organ, we were able to save the spleen, which is crucial for the body's immune system, especially in a young patient. This procedure was complex, with the tumor attached to the splenic capsule, but was completed successfully.

The patient has made a full recovery and is now in good health. Post-operative analysis of the resected tumor confirmed that the tumor is benign, ensuring that the patient received complete treatment. This achievement highlights our team's expertise and commitment to advanced care and providing the best possible outcomes for our patients.


















Shura Council
